A 'God Thing'... ...by Tony Jackson

We were blessed to do campus ministry for 25 years, ministering to and alongside hundreds of university students at SIUE, Washington University and St. Louis University. We got to help them think through their views on life, the universe, God, and everything. We experienced lots of ups and downs as we did life with them.

Often, we would pray for them and with them about situations and people that they were concerned about. Sometimes, when the circumstances or people changed in the ways a student wanted, they would exclaim: "It's a God thing!" I would often respond with: "Maybe...but if it had *not* worked out like you wanted it to, would it still be a 'God thing'?"

I wanted to teach them that faith in God is trust in him...not just saying the magic words (in prayer) or rubbing the magic lamp and having the genie grant wishes. Trust in God means we believe He is with us and that he sees and knows and cares. Faith in Him means we believe this is just as true when our negative or painful circumstances do not change, when He leaves us in them. There is a passage of scripture that I often hear misused and misquoted: Jeremiah 29:11. "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

The context of this verse is a letter to the Israelites that have been taken into Babylonian captivity. God, through Jeremiah, is saying to them that they (the original recipients of the letter) are not going anywhere. He tells them to work hard for this pagan kingdom (Babylon) so that it will be successful and since God is not going to rescue them immediately (as most were saying and hoping and false prophets were capitalizing on) that they should settle down, take spouses and have kids because you're going to be staying here for a long time, not being freed and not going back to the promised land. God did not remove them from trouble back into comfort or remove the terrible circumstances they were in.

Some Believers equate God's unwillingness to prevent bad circumstances from happening, or to change them into good circumstances, given his awareness "ahead of time", with his planning, or making them happen. I don't think this accurately reflects his nature or represents clear thinking. Many Christians I have met seem to subscribe to this view, where God orchestrates it all and they are content with viewing him this way. I don't believe this represents great faith.

Our world has been disrupted at every level by rebellion (sin) against God and his created order. This has negatively impacted us and the world in many ways. This is not God's fault, and was not orchestrated by him. People bear the responsibility for using their Godgiven free will against their Creator. Thank God he does not leave us here! Jesus (who Paul calls "the second Adam") comes to undo what the first Adam did, and to establish himself as Lord and King of God's kingdom. Our savior invites us to follow him and to join him in restoring his father's kingdom and furthering his agenda of calling people back to himself. This is the blessing and work of the church.

The exiles who got Jeremiah's letter were told not to listen to the false prophets that kept telling what they wanted to hear; that God would soon release them and make it all better. He told them at a time in the future (after most of them had died) that God would rescue and restore some of their descendants, but they were called to be faithful and endure captivity by the pagan nation who had taken them away.

God walks with us...is with us always - even when things don't work out or change in the ways we believe they should. It's a God thing either way. I believe this is true of my life, your life, and the life of BCC, regardless of circumstances. You and I are called to be faithful, to trust God and live for Jesus as we serve and seek others together and share the Good News about Jesus with them.



We're up to 97 families and 184 children that have been touched by this ministry and loved on by our volunteers.














Come early to enjoy free coffee & tea. Come sit & connect with others.
